The DALMAC Fund was established in 1975. Half of the proceeds from the Dick Allen Lansing to Mackinaw bicycle tour, DALMAC, are transferred to the DALMAC Fund Inc., a 501 c 3 charity created to promote bicycling in Michigan.

#### The DALMAC Fund goals:

- 1. Improve the bicycling environment in Michigan
- 2. Expand bicycling in Michigan
- 3. Promote good will towards bicycling in the community
- 4. Increase bicycle safety

#### Grant requests will be evaluated on meeting the 4 goals, as well as,

- 1. The amount requested is reasonable
- 2. TCBA is comfortable funding the request
- 3. The request has local support
- 4. Funding one year does not guarantee funding in future years
- 5. Facility requests will be commented on by the Michigan Trails and Greenways Alliance

#### Typical grant funded requests involve,

- 1. Construction and design of bicycle facilities
- 2. Bicycle education programs
- 3. Bicycle promotion activities
- 4. Purchase of bicycles and related equipment
- 5. Developing bicycle routes or maps (not facilities)

The DALMAC Fund grants are now awarded by the DALMAC Fund Inc., recognized by the IRS as a charitable organization in 2018. DALMAC's founder, Dick Allen, passed away in 2021. Grant application and instructions are available at www.DALMAC.org.
